Although the Fox River Navigational System Authority is appropriated \$30,700 in 2006-07 from the water resources account of the conservation fund, the 2005-07 biennial budget act required the Authority to submit its 2007-09 budget request to the Governor as though \$126,700 SEG was provided to the Authority as base level funding in 2006-07.

On September 17, 2004, the Fox River locks system was transferred from federal ownership to the state and thereafter the Fox River Navigational System Authority assumed responsibility for the repair, rehabilitation, maintenance, and operation of the system. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers was previously responsible for the 17 locks and approximately 90 acres of land along the Fox River from Lake Winnebago to Green Bay.
